About

Food testing laboratory helps food processing industry in ensuring safety and quality of food products. These labs analyse samples from restaurants, hotels, snack manufacturing units etc to ensure the compliance of domestic and international standards on food. The main objective of food testing laboratories is to monitor the quality and composition of food and their compliance with Food Safety Regulations.

There are about 60 NABL accredited food testing laboratories in India and 6 NABL accredited food testing laboratories in Telangana. However, Andhra Pradesh has only one such lab, thus presenting a business opportunity for entrepreneurs.

Budget

The total capital required including land & infrastructure cost, machinery, civil structure etc would be upwards of R. 50 lakhs.

Schemes from Government
